Summer Reading and Summer Math: As we do every year, we will continue to have our Summer Reading program. There will be both recommended and required reading assignments in most grades. We will have them posted on the website this week.

This year, we will introduce a Summer Math program. This is part of our Middle States Action Plan. Students entering Grades 1 and 2 will receive a printed (and posted) assignment. For students entering Grades 3 to 8, we are asking them to complete the "Get Ready for the next Grade" program. The purpose of this program is to have your child prepared for the material that will be taught in the next grade Math and to prevent summer learning loss.
